Dear Parents/Carers of Year 11 pupils,

We are committed to supporting our pupils to academic success, and are delighted to announce that as part of the government's National Tutoring Programme, we have signed up with CoachBright to support some of our pupils with tuition in English and Maths.

CoachBright work with pupils 1-2 to help them become independent and resilient learners so they can lead the lives they want. Pupils are matched with a university student tutor to work with them to improve their grades, confidence and independence.

Pupils will meet their tutors once a week and will focus on 1 subject, working towards reaching their individual goal which they will set together at the start of the programme. Sessions are very personalised and will be pupil-led, allowing your child to have input into topics covered and how they like to learn.

The programme is 12 weeks long and finishes with a graduation celebration event. The academic coaching sessions are on **Wednesdays** at school and will start after half term from 15:30-16:30.

The first session on Wednesday 23rd February will be 1 hour, and this will kick off the programme! Pupils will spend time getting to know more about university, apprenticeships and options after school as well as getting to know the programme and meeting their tutor for the first time! They'll then set their goal for the programme and let their tutor know how they work best.

During the course of the programme, we would love your help in reminding your child when the tutoring sessions are and helping them to attend. This works best if you remind them the morning of their session, or the day before! The school will also be reminding pupils on the day.

If you're happy for your child to take part in the CoachBright programme, you don't need to do anything further!
