- Title

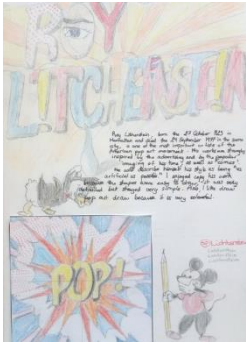
1. Before gluing, place your work on an A4 piece of paper.
